



PETITION RELEASE POLITICAL PRISONERS TIBET

With the protests in Tibet since March 2008 more and more Tibetans have been detained in prison. Now there are more than 6.000 Tibetans in jail.

They are often arrested and imprisoned only because of their participation in a peaceful protest. They demand a free Tibet and the return of H.H. the Dalai Lama to Tibet. Most prisoners are a monk or a nun.

The number of executions has also increased. Since March last year more than 200 Tibetans were killed and more than 1.000 are still missing.

Support this petition for the unconditional release of all political prisoners in Tibet.

On the 10th of December 2009, the Human Rights Day, this petition will be submitted to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Brussels.
